Conditions for Importation of Cut Flowers

The permit is issued subject to the conditions stated below. The Plant Quarantine Authority of the BVI reserves the right to render this permit void at any time, when its judgement, such is deemed necessary.

- (1) An Import Permit must be requested at least 48 hours before any consignment is sourced or procured.
- (2) All cut flowers must show no visible sign of pests or diseases.
- (3) The cut flowers must be accompanied by a completed Phyto-sanitary Certificate (quantities, weights and type of cut flowers) issued by the Plant Quarantine Authority in the country of origin.
- (4) Cut flowers must be cleaned, trimmed, treated with an insecticide and fungicide, counted or weighed and packaged in approved containers and certified by the Plant Quarantine Authority.
- (5) ALL REQUIRED CONDITIONS MUST BE MET AND ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS (IMPORT PERMIT AND PHTO-SANITARY CERTIFICATE) MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE PORT OF ENTRY, IN ORDER TO FACILITATE PLANT QUARANTINE CLEARANCE.
- (6) THE CROP AND PLANT QUARANTINE DIVISION MUST BE GIVEN AT LEAST 48 HOURS NOTICE OF CONFIRMED ARRIVAL, DATE, TIME, AIRLINE/VESSEL AND PORT OF ENTRY. THIS WILL FACILITATE UNNECESSARY DELAYS AND CONFISCATION OF CONSIGNMENT.
